



HOW TO GET TO GLYN NEWYDD HOMESTEAD

From Sydney, follow the Great western highway till you get to the town of Blackheath. Here you turn left at the traffic lights, then left again into Station Street. Turn first right into Shipley Road, then first left again into Megalong Road. Continue down the winding road and enjoy the beautiful scenery in the Glen. Here you will pass signs to Mermaid Cave & Coachwood Glen, 2 walking trails that will take you through some beautiful rain-forest. 8 Kilometers along Megalong Road you will reach the valley floor, if you look up to the left you will see the Hydro Majestic high up on the escarpment, and you will find the Megalong Tearooms a little bit further on your right. Continue to follow Megalong Road, you will be passing rolling pastures with cattle and horses, the local public school and Megalong Creek (the perfect place for warm summer days to cool down, have a swim in the waterholes or enjoy a picnic on the rocks). Shortly after the creek you will see signs to the 6 Foot track, which runs from Katoomba to the Jenolan Caves and crosses Megalong Road here. You can walk part of this track both ways. The road now turns into a gravel Road and you will find Glyn Newydd exactly 3 km up hill from here on your right hand side. Turn into the drive way, and Glyn Newydd homestead is on the left.
